


Welcome to Denver!

CU Anschutz Medical Campus

Retail Therapy

<u>Larimer Square</u> What began as Denver's first city block is today one of the city's most chic fashion districts.

<u>16th Street Mall</u> Adjacent to Larimar Square, you'll encounter the sprawling 16-block, I.M. Peidesigned pedestrian mall that stands as Metro Denver's No. 1 tourist attraction. It's easy to see why: 16th Street is packed with restaurants, cafes, public art - and of course, a cornucopia of shopping options.

<u>Cherry Creek North</u> and <u>Cherry Creek Shopping Center</u> Just a 25-minute drive from the Benson Hotel, Cherry Creek North is a 16-block walkable district, featuring the region's largest collection of independently owned shops, boutiques, galleries, restaurants and spas. Nearby Cherry Creek Shopping Center is the "high end" shopping center in town (think Tiffany & Co, Louis Vuitton)

Taste of Denver: Union Station

Parks & Green Spaces

Denver has a multitude of parks and green spaces all over the city—great for soaking up Colorado's 300 days of sunshine.



Washington Park

Wash Park is one of Denver's biggest, oldest, and most popular. The outer unpaved 2.5-mile loop is a beautiful run or walk, and the inner paved route is perfect for walking or biking. You can rent a bike or for this loop or rent a paddle boat or paddle board and hang out on Smith Lake. There are often volleyball nets set up for use on warmer days.

• <u>City Park</u>

The enormous and diverse City Park has something for everyone, with jogging paths, a public golf course, fountains, flower gardens, lakes, and plenty of open lawn. The views of the Denver skyline in front of the Rockies are amazing.

<u>Confluence Park</u>

At the confluence of Cherry Creek and the South Platte River is appropriately named Confluence Park. A popular spot for some urban kayaking, Confluence Park is as popular for its water as it is for its land.

Bonus: it also borders Denver's flagship REI. Want to make a day of it? Bike down the Cherry Creek Trail and connect to the South Platte Trail at Confluence Park.


Hiking Trails
