The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center and the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Health in Columbus are recruiting a **full-time, one-year (2024-2025) Postdoctoral Fellow** in Women's Behavioral Health (WBH) for our growing, interdisciplinary program serving women across the adult lifespan. Ideal candidates will have a doctoral degree (Ph.D. or Psy.D.) in clinical or counseling psychology. Preference will be given to applicants with interest and experience in women's behavioral health or health psychology.

This is an exciting opportunity to gain valuable outpatient clinical experiences in diagnostic intake assessments and the delivery of psychotherapy services. We provide patients with state-of-the-art care for mood and anxiety disorders, sexual health, substance use disorders and stress, with a special emphasis on the peripartum, gynecologic and breast cancers, menopause, and the menstrual cycle. In addition to providing clinical services, the fellow will participate in regularly scheduled training activities, such as weekly individual and group supervision with a licensed psychologist(s) and didactic sessions. Various elective opportunities are available, including a research elective with the Director of Women's Behavioral Health, Dr. Kristen Carpenter. The fellow will work closely with interdisciplinary team members across the medical center and other WBH trainees.

Responsibilities include the following:

**Provision of clinical services (80%)**

- Conducting behavioral health diagnostic intake assessments, individual psychotherapy, and group psychotherapy within the Women's Behavioral Health (WBH) team (three days/week).
- Conducting behavioral health diagnostic intake assessments, individual psychotherapy, and/or group psychotherapy as indicated within a secondary rotation (one day/week). Examples of possible secondary rotations (dependent on supervisor availability):
  - Depression Recovery Center
  - Anxiety Disorders Clinic
  - Suicide Prevention and Trauma
  - Sleep Medicine
  - Pain Medicine
  - Research elective

Clinical administrative and supervision will be incorporated into rotation days.

**Didactics/Professional Development/Research (20%)**

- The fellow will be expected to participate in fellowship didactics, departmental Grand Rounds, and other departmental educational opportunities as agreed upon with the mentor(s).
- The fellow will have the opportunity to have a mentored research experience. This could take the place of a secondary rotation (pending funding).
- The fellow will be expected to participate in professional development activities as agreed upon with the mentor(s).

We also require a letter from your dissertation chair regarding the status of your dissertation or proof of successful completion of dissertation. All requirements for degree, including an APA accredited psychology program and internship, must be completed prior to start date and will be verified. Application submission is open and applications will be accepted on a rolling basis. Early applications preferred. Interviews will be conducted VIRTUALLY and will continue until positions are filled.
